

Directions to
Pontiac Park on Bull Shoals and
Jordan's Landing on Norfolk Lake

From Kansas City take Hwy 71 South for about 39 miles to Harrisonville or
From Independence take Hwy 291 South for about 36 miles to Harrisonville or
From Lee's Summit take Hwy 291 South for about 20 miles to Harrisonville or
From Blue Springs take Hwy 7 South for about 35 miles to Harrisonville.

From Harrisonville take Hwy 71 South 3 miles to Hwy 7.
Take Hwy 7 SE 39 miles to Clinton. (Hwy 7 becomes Hwy 13 in Clinton)
From Clinton take Hwy 13 South for 83 miles to I-44 at Springfield.
Take I-44 East 4.5 miles to Hwy 65.
Take Hwy 65 South for 8.6 miles to Hwy 60.
Take Hwy 60 East for 38 miles to Hwy 5 at Mansfield.
From Mansfield take Hwy 5 South for 49 miles to Hwy 160 at Gainesville.
From Gainesville take Hwy 160 West (its also Hwy 5) for 2 miles to Hwy 5 South.
(It is now 15 miles to Pontiac and 45 miles to Jordan's Landing)

To Pontiac Park on Bull Shoals:

From Hwy 160 take Hwy 5 South for 5 miles to County Road W.
Take Hwy W West for about 8-10 miles to Pontiac Park Campgrounds on Bull Shoals.

To Jordan's Landing on Norfolk Lake:

From Hwy 160 take Hwy 5 South for 24 miles to Mountain Home.
Continue South on Hwy 5 for 11 miles to Hwy 177 at Salesville.
Take Hwy 177 East for 6 miles (crossing the dam) to Jordan.
Take Hwy 64 North for 3 or 4 miles to the Jordan Recreation Area on Norfolk Lake.

Note: The last time we were there, the gas prices were very high in Mountain Home.

Directions to
Stockton State Park Campground
On Stockton Lake

From Kansas City take Hwy 71 South for about 39 miles to Harrisonville or
From Independence take Hwy 291 South for about 36 miles to Harrisonville or
From Lee's Summit take Hwy 291 South for about 20 miles to Harrisonville or
From Blue Springs take Hwy 7 South to Harrisonville.

From Harrisonville take Hwy 71 South for 54 miles to Hwy 54 at Nevada.
From Nevada take Hwy 54 East 18 miles to El Dorado Springs.

If you are pulling a boat,

Continue East from El Dorado Springs on Hwy 54 for 7 miles to Hwy 39 South.
Go South on Hwy 39 the 15 miles to Hwy 32.
Go East 1 mile on Hwy 32 to the Stockton 4-Way Stop.

If you are NOT pulling a boat,

From El Dorado Springs take Hwy 32 South the 22 miles to the Stockton 4-Way
Stop. (Hwy 39 is wider than Hwy 32)

From the Stockton 4-Way Stop take Hwy 39 South for 2 miles to Hwy 215.
Go East on Hwy 215 for about 6 miles, crossing the Stockton Lake Bridge.
A couple of miles past the bridge turn left onto the park road to the State Park
Campgrounds, Marina, Motel and Restaurant. Careful, the turn-off to the campground
sneaks up on you.

Note: The Stockton Campground, Orleans Trails Campground and Marina are located on
the South edge of Stockton and East of Hwy 39. Air is available at both the Orleans Trail
Marina and the State Park Marina.

Note: The State Park Restaurant is good but check their hours. Stockton also has a few
nice places to eat.

Directions to
Kimberling City and
Baxter Campgrounds
On Table Rock Lake

From Kansas City take Hwy 71 South for about 39 miles to Harrisonville or
From Independence take Hwy 291 South for about 36 miles to Harrisonville or
From Lee's Summit take Hwy 291 South for about 20 miles to Harrisonville or
From Blue Springs take Hwy 7 South for about 35 miles to Harrisonville.

From Harrisonville take Hwy 71 South 3 miles to Hwy 7.
Take Hwy 7 SE 39 miles to Clinton. (Hwy 7 becomes Hwy 13 in Clinton)
From Clinton take Hwy 13 and go 83 miles South to Springfield.
Stay on Hwy 13 in Springfield for 5 miles after crossing I-44 to Hwy 160 going south.
Go South on Hwy 160 for 31 miles to Hwy 248.
Take Hwy 248 West for 2 miles to Hwy 13.
Take Hwy 13 South for 10 Miles to Kimberling City.
The Port of Kimberling Marina & Campground is located .5 Miles East of Hwy 13. Look
for Port of Kimberling sign.

To Baxter Campgrounds:

From Kimberling City continue South on Hwy 13 for 6 miles to Hwy H at Lampe.
Take Hwy H West for 4.8 miles to the Baxter Campgrounds.

Directions to
Lost Bridge North and
Lost Bridge South on
Beaver Lake, Arkansas

From Kansas City take Hwy 71 South for about 39 miles to Harrisonville or
From Independence take Hwy 291 South for about 36 miles to Harrisonville or
From Lee's Summit take Hwy 291 South for about 20 miles to Harrisonville or
From Blue Springs take Hwy 7 South to Harrisonville.

From Harrisonville take Hwy 71 South for 112 miles to I-44.
Continue on Hwy 71 as it goes West with I-44 for 5 or 6 miles before turning South.
Continue South on Hwy 71 for 45 miles to the Arkansas State Line.
Continue South on Hwy 71 for about 13 miles to Hwy 62 in Rogers.
Go East on Hwy 62 for about 14 miles to Hwy 127 at Garfield.
Turn South on Hwy 127 for about 6 miles.
After the 6 miles from Garfield there is a fork in the road. Lost Bridge North is to the
Left and Lost Bridge South is to the Right. You are just minutes from your campsite.

Lost Bridge North has the solar heated showers, just inside the gate, flush toilets, up the
hill from the boat ramp and the Lost Bridge Marina with air refills.

Air fill Warning: They check your C-Card, the dates on your tank, the burst disk and the
PSI of your tank. The burst disk must match your tank size and they won't fill a tank that
is too empty.

Note: Soon after leaving Garfield, watch for the Cross The Creek Restaurant. It's on a
curve at the bottom of a hill. They have a great all-you-can-eat dinner on Friday and
Saturday nights for something like \$18-\$22. Garfield has one place to eat but it's pretty
bad, your best choice besides Cross-The-Creek is back in Rogers

Directions to Buck Creek on Bull Shoals

From Kansas City take Hwy 71 South for about 39 miles to Harrisonville or
From Independence take Hwy 291 South for about 36 miles to Harrisonville or
From Lee's Summit take Hwy 291 South for about 20 miles to Harrisonville or
From Blue Springs take Hwy 7 South for about 35 miles to Harrisonville.

From Harrisonville take Hwy 71 South 3 miles to Hwy 7.
Take Hwy 7 SE 39 miles to Clinton. (Hwy 7 becomes Hwy 13 in Clinton)
From Clinton take Hwy 13 South for 83 miles to I-44 at Springfield.
Take I-44 East 4.5 miles to Hwy 65.
Take Hwy 65 South for about 16 miles to the second Ozark exit to Hwy 14.
Go East on Hwy 14 for about 8 miles to Sparta and Hwy 125.
Take Hwy 125 South for 55 miles to the Buck Creek Campground.

Note: Between the campground entrance and Hwy 125 is the short road to the Buck Creek Marina. In late 2002 they were considering obtaining the necessary equipment for supplying SCUBA air.

Note: Going South of Buck Creek on Hwy 125 requires the use of a ferry. The ferry only runs during daylight hours. The Highway 125 Marina is at the South end of the ferry ride and contains a good restaurant. During 2002 the marina's compressor stopped working.

Note: 1 mile back into Missouri is a small gas station and grocery store with an even smaller restaurant attached.

Directions to
Table Rock State Park
On Table Rock Lake

From Kansas City take Hwy 71 South for about 39 miles to Harrisonville or
From Independence take Hwy 291 South for about 36 miles to Harrisonville or
From Lee's Summit take Hwy 291 South for about 20 miles to Harrisonville or
From Blue Springs take Hwy 7 South for about 35 miles to Harrisonville.

From Harrisonville take Hwy 71 South 3 miles to Hwy 7.
Take Hwy 7 SE 39 miles to Clinton. (Hwy 7 becomes Hwy 13 in Clinton)
From Clinton take Hwy 13 South for 83 miles to I-44 at Springfield.
Take I-44 East 4.5 miles to Hwy 65.
Take Hwy 65 South for 33 miles Hwy 165 just past Branson.
Take Hwy 65 West for 5-7 miles to the Table Rock State Park entrance. If you get to the
Branson Bell or the Dam, you are too far west.

Note: The State Park does not take reservations.
